



Advantages of recumbent over upright trikes

1. Low sitting position

A recumbent trike has a lower center of gravity, which reduces the risk of tipping over in corners or on sloping terrain. This also means that “unruly” riding is much less likely to result in an accident.

2. Easy and safe mounting and dismounting

Owing to the fact that the seat position of our trikes is only a little lower than that of a wheelchair, mounting and dismounting is also easy and safe for wheelchair users.

3. Seat with mesh cover

The comfortable seat makes it possible for the rider to sit safely without having to hold onto anything. Riders can relax, focus their full attention on the pedaling motion and enjoy the wonderful feeling of independent mobility.

4. Legs out in front

The recumbent position offers a great advantage for riders who have problems moving their legs in a pedaling motion: they can see their own legs and watch how they move, which makes pedaling much easier.

5. Medical-aid number

HASE BIKES is the only manufacturer of sportive therapeutic, recumbent trikes with a medical-aid number (in Germany). This means that the cost of these models (TRIX and TRETTS) is usually covered by insurance providers. Furthermore, all of our models are CE certified as medical devices according to the EU Directive 93/42/EEC.

6. Can be hitched to bikes

Both the TRIX and the TRETTS REH can be hitched to conventional bikes, and the TRIX is also equipped with an overrun brake. The towing option significantly increases riding distance and speed, e.g. on family excursions (social integration).

7. The torso doesn't have to be braced

Children who have trouble holding their body in an upright position do not have to be braced in the mesh seat (no special supports required).

8. “Cool” looks

Recumbent trikes look sporty, cool, and not at all “disabled.” Children and adolescents love riding them and are admired by their peers, which boosts confidence and social integration.

AND IN ADDITION: THE PINO ADVANTAGE – Tandem with recumbent seat in front

The child sits safely in the recumbent seat, can help with the pedaling, enjoys a panoramic view of the surroundings, and feels the wind on their face. The adult rider can easily see the child in front, and communication is effortless because they are in such close proximity.
